
villages with their

There are country walks to the River Avon and the village of Luddington.











Shakespeare Country



Using Dodwell Park as a base, you can enjoy the delights not only of Shakespeare's hometown, but also the nearby surrounding shire counties of Oxfordshire, Worcestershire & Gloucestershire. **Eniov Warwick Castle** and Henley in Arden to the north. Blenheim Palace and the Cotswolds to the south. Worcester and the Malverns to the west and all within an hour's journey of Stratford itself.

On leaving Stratfordupon-Avon, take the B439 signposted "B439 Bidford" (also signposted Stratford Racecourse) for 2 miles, go past the Racecourse turn off and you will then find us on the left (after going over a large hill).
